Beef Dinner Fund Raiser

For our November roast beef dinner we asked for donations to help offset the cost of the food and also for help the day of the dinner. It is amazing how this congregation comes together to support church projects. A large part of the food was paid for by donations and there is no way we could have served over 500 people in less than three hours without the volunteers who helped serve and clean up. Our profit was \$3,740.48.

In the quilt/fabric sale, there were 67 finished quilts, wall hangings and table toppers, as well as over 600 yards of bundled fabric for sale. These were all donated items from Leigh Green and the estate of Don and Yvonne Clark. The majority of the items were sold. This sale resulted in a profit of \$2,572.20 to be used for the kitchen in our new church. The committee thanks you for your generous support.

Any unsold fabric will be used by the newly formed quilt committee of the AUMC to make potholders to sell and girls' dresses to be shipped to Haiti.

The Thanksgiving pie sale was also very successful. Thank you for donating some of the ingredients for the pies. We thought last year was big by making 131 pies but this year topped that mark with 242 pies made. It was a tiring long day and we ended up selling all the pies. Our profit was \$1,620.39.

We want to thank everyone who donated their time and money toward these two projects. Without you it would not have been possible.
